The rooms on the top floor (known as 'Sous Les Toits') offer breathtaking views over the city's iconic rooftops. On your return, take time to appreciate the fascinating works from regional artists and students, adorning the walls on the ground floor, or relax

in the comfort of the hotel bar with a favourite drink in hand. It's frequented by guests and locals alike, so if you're looking for the perfect place to eat, why not chat with one of the friendly regulars? Both the locals and hotel employees will be only too happy to impart their knowledge of the surrounding area.
